Rules



- Entry deadline is April 28, 2023. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Organizer (with a \$20 Late Entry Fee). No refunds after entries received.
- Age as of May 13, 2023.
- Scrutineering shall be conducted as recommended by RSOBHD. Dancers will be judged according to the technique of the RSOBHD. The judge's decisions will be final and there will be no access to the judge's sheets.
- Age categories will be based on the number of registrations in each classification. First to enter, last to dance.
- Dancers will pick up their numbers at the registration table upon verification of their current RSOBHD card.
- Medals and trophies will be awarded in all categories except in Primary where no trophy is awarded. The oldest Premier group will receive cash prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings.
- Mother's Day Fling and Hornpipe will not be included in the High Aggregate.
- Dancers must report to Marshalling Area when their group is called or risk disqualification.
- No coaching while dancers are on stage. Teachers and parents WILL NOT BE PERMITTED in the lineup area, unless assigned as the Marshall.
- Designated change areas will be provided. There is to be no changing in public areas, nor will the dancers be permitted to be in public areas wearing bra tops or sports bras with dickies. Please ensure that dancers are ready to dance when they arrive in Marshalling area as Marshalls are not permitted to fix costumes.
- Dancers must be in full dress to receive awards (including slippers).
- No flash photography while dancers are competing on stage.
- Any protest must be lodged in writing and postmarked within 48 hours, accompanied by a fee of \$25 which will be returned if the protest is upheld.
- The Smith Highland Dancers will not be responsible for lost articles, accidents, injuries or illness to competitors or spectators at the competition.

SCOTDANCE CANADA COMPETITION/WORKSHOP WAIVER FORM

I am aware that participating in the Guysborough Highland Dancing Competition involves the potential for risks, dangers and hazards, including but not limited to:

(a) injury to myself / my child as a result of the physical nature of dance competition and performance; and (b) the taking and/or release of unauthorized photographs, video and/or other recordings of myself and/or my child, notwithstanding efforts to enforce Event policies.

In consideration of my / my child's participation in the Guysborough Highland Dancing Competition and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, I hereby WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS against ScotDance Canada, its directors, agents, employees, executive members, volunteers and organizers of the Guysborough Highland Dancing Competition (the "Releasees"), which I now have, or hereafter may have against the Releasees. In particular, but without limiting the foregoing, I agree to release the Releasees from ANY AND ALL LIABILITY for any loss, damage, injury, or expense I / my child may incur as a result of my /my child's participation in or attendance at the Guysborough Highland Dancing Competition. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees from ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, INJURY OR EXPENSE, including legal costs, that the Releasees may incur due to my / my child's participation in or attendance at the Guysborough Highland Dancing Competition, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise, and whether caused to my child or otherwise. I understand that the Releasees will photograph and otherwise record the Guysborough Highland Dancing Competition, its participants and attendees. I consent to and authorize such recording. I further consent to and authorize the Releasees to publish my/my child's image, likeness and information in any medium, including but not limited to photographs, videos, DVDs, and webcasts. I understand that this publication will take place in the public domain, including in printed materials, public announcements, and on the internet.

I specifically consent to the public release of the following information: 1. Name; 2. City, Province, Country of Residence; 3. Tartan; 4. Age; 5. Results.

I acknowledge that by signing and submitting this entry, electronically or otherwise, that I have read this agreement carefully and fully understand it and agree to all of the above terms and conditions.

This waiver & declaration must be completed prior to or upon visiting the venue and before participating in any activity.

RELATING TO CORONAVIRUS/COVID 19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19 has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is known to spread mainly by contact from person to person. Consequently, local, provincial and federal governmental authorities recommend various measures and prohibit a variety of behaviors, in order to reduce the spread of the virus.

ScotDance Nova Scotia and ScotDance Canada and its members commit themselves to comply with the requirements and recommendations of National, Provincial and local Public health and other governmental authorities, and to put in place and adopt all necessary measures to that effect. However, ScotDance Nova Scotia and ScotDance Canada cannot guarantee that you (or your child, if participant is a minor/ or the person you are the legal guardian of) will not become infected with COVID-19. I declare that I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) am participating voluntarily in ScotDance Nova Scotia/ScotDance Canada's activities.

I declare that neither I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) nor anyone in my household, have experienced in the last 14 days prior to the date of ScotDance New Scotia/ScotDance Canada, cold or flu-like symptoms (including fever, cough, sore throat, respiratory illness, difficulty breathing) and or have travelled from outside of Canada and been asked to quarantine upon return/entry into Canada.

If I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) experience, or if anyone in my household experiences any cold or flu-like symptoms after submitting this declaration, I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) will not attend any of ScotDance Nova Scotia/ScotDance Canada's activities, programs or services until at least 14 days have passed since those symptoms were last experienced.

I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) agree to the requirements and recommendations of National, Provincial and local Public health and other governmental authorities and to those special safety regulations put in place by ScotDance Nova Scotia/ScotDance Canada as it pertains the Covid-19 Coronavirus and to adopt all necessary measures to those effects.

I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) agree that, by filling out and signing this waiver and agreeing to the terms and conditions set out in it, I am giving up my legal rights to sue ScotDance Nova Scotia/ScotDance Canada and its officers and directors, in the event that I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of), contracts the Covid-19 Coronavirus.
